*The queen of spin beveling is Andrea Wiley.*



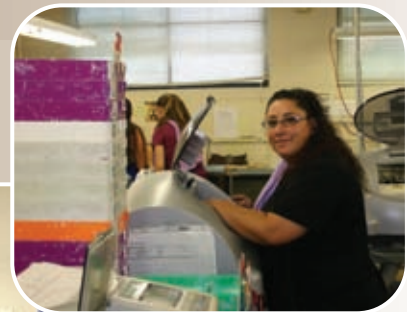

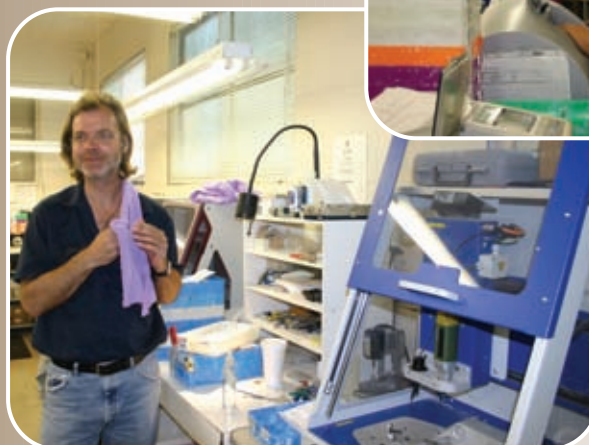
